COMMENDING Officer Paul Moore upon the occasion of being named the 2021 Corrections Officer of the Year

WHEREAS, Officer Paul Moore immediately reacted, and went to Officer Kelly and asked if he was ok; after he shook his head no, Officer Moore realized he was choking, and his skin was quickly changing color; and

WHEREAS, Using his medical first aid training, Officer Paul Moore quickly administered the Heimlich Maneuver, however, his first series of thrusts were unsuccessful in dislodging the object Officer Kelly was choking on; after using harder thrusts, the object was finally dislodged, and Officer Kelly was able to breathe and talk again; and

WHEREAS, Due to Officer Paul Moore's astute and heroic actions, Officer Keenan Kelly was saved from certain death; not only were his actions remarkable, but his humble demeanor afterward was extraordinary; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those dedicated public servants who unselfishly devote their lives to the preservation of order and the protection of others are worthy and due full praise for their commitment and noble endeavors; now, therefore, be it
