AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to amending the definition of a "public body"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 102 of the public officers law, as amended by chapter 704 of the laws of 1979 and such section as renumbered by chapter 652 of the laws of 1983, is amended to read as follows: 2. "Public body" means any entity, for which a quorum is required in 4 order to conduct public business and which consists of two or more members, performing a governmental function for the state or for an agency or department thereof, or for a public corporation as defined in 7 section sixty-six of the general construction law, or committee or subcommittee or other similar body consisting of members of such public 9 10 body or an entity created or appointed to perform a necessary function 11 in the decision-making process. A necessary function in the decision-12 making process shall not include the provision of recommendations or guidance which is purely advisory and which does not require further 13 action by the state or agency or department thereof or public corpo-14 15 ration as defined in section sixty-six of the general construction law. 16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
