AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to the percentage of free play allowance credits

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 3 of subdivision i of section 1617-a of the tax law, as amended by section 1 of part SS of chapter 60 of the laws of 2 2016, is amended to read as follows:

(3) For each video lottery facility, the annual value of the free play allowance credits authorized for use by the operator pursuant to this subdivision shall not exceed an amount equal to fifteen percent of the total amount wagered on video lottery games after payout of prizes. The gaming commission shall establish procedures to assure that free play allowance credits do not exceed such amount. However, the commission 10 may, at the commission's discretion, authorize an increase to the above limitation for individual video lottery facilities, upon illustration of

12 benefit to the state.
