AN ACT to amend the private housing finance law, in relation to establishing the sustainable affordable housing incentive program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The private housing finance law is amended by adding a new article 32 to read as follows:

ARTICLE XXXII

§ 1290. Statement of legislative findings and purpose. The legislature finds and declares that climate change is having a significant impact upon our environment, health, and safety and it is necessary to implement programs and policies that immediately reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The legislature further finds that residential housing is a source for such emissions and we can only address climate change in a meaningful manner if we change our practices and behaviors as they 15 relate to the construction of and improvements to such housing, such as 16 the use of environmentally-sensitive design and the construction practices and materials; the installation of energy efficient products; and 17 access to renewable energy sources. Establishing a new program to 18 19 encourage and publicly subsidize more environmentally-friendly practices

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and materials will reduce greenhouse gas emissions from multi-unit housing throughout New York state and help address climate change for future 3 generations.

- § 1291. Definitions. For the purposes of this article, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
- 1. "Corporation" shall mean the housing trust fund corporation estab-<u>lished</u> in section forty-five-a of this chapter.
- 8 2. "Sustainable affordable housing activities" shall mean activities by an eligible applicant for a specific work or series of works for the 9 10 creation, preservation or improvement of affordable housing which will 11 reduce greenhouse gas emissions through the use of design, construction, 12 materials and products, and access to renewable energy sources that exceed a greenhouse gas emissions baseline for such housing, as deter-13 14 mined by the corporation in consultation with the New York state energy 15 research and development corporation.
- 3. "Eligible applicant" shall mean a not-for-profit corporation or 16 17 charitable organization, or a wholly-owned subsidiary of such a corporation or organization, or a private for-profit developer such as a 18 person, corporation, partnership or limited liability company. 19
- 4. "Affordable residential development" shall mean a multiple family 21 dwelling which is subject to a regulatory agreement with a local, state, 22 or federal government entity.
 - § 1292. Sustainable affordable housing incentive program. 1. Within amounts appropriated or otherwise available therefor, the corporation shall develop and administer a sustainable affordable housing incentive program which shall provide assistance in the form of payments, grants and loans for reasonable and necessary expenses to an eligible applicant for sustainable housing activities.
- 2. The corporation shall develop procedures, criteria and requirements 29 30 related to the application and award of projects pursuant to this section which shall include: eligibility, market demand, feasibility 31 32 and funding criteria; the funding determination process; supervision and 33 evaluation of contracting applicants; reporting, budgeting and record-34 keeping requirements; provisions for modification and termination of contracts; and such other matters not inconsistent with the purposes and 35 36 provisions of this article as the corporation shall deem necessary or 37 appropriate.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
