AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to counting of affidavit ballots

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph (iii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 9-209 of the election law, as amended by chapter 308 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

(iii) If the board of elections determines that a person was entitled to vote at such election, the board shall cast and canvass such ballot if such board finds that the voter appeared at [the correct] a polling place in the correct county, regardless of the fact that the voter may have appeared in the incorrect election district; provided that such vote shall not be cast and canvassed for such contests for which the person was not entitled to vote at such election.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
