AN ACT relating to speed limits in the village of Pittsford, town of Pittsford, county of Monroe

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any general, special or local law or code to the contrary, the village board of the village of Pittsford in the town of Pittsford in Monroe county may by local law, ordinance, order, rule or regulation establish maximum speed limits at not less than twenty-five miles per hour on any portion of the following streets within such village: State Street, Monroe Avenue, South Main Street, North Main Street, East Jefferson Road, West Jefferson Road, and Washington Road.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
