AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to the proper form of exhibits ${\ensuremath{\mathsf{E}}}$

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Rule 2101 of the civil practice law and rules is amended by adding a new subdivision (h) to read as follows:
- 3 (h) Exhibits. Every exhibit shall be clearly identified, but no 4 specific method of labeling shall be required. The rejection of any 5 submission shall not be solely based on the mislabeling of any exhibit.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
