AN ACT in relation to directing the state liquor authority to extend liquor licenses for on-premise alcohol retailers for a period of one year

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
- 2 the state liquor authority shall extend all current liquor licenses for
- 3 on-premise alcohol retailers through January 31, 2022. Such extension
- 4 shall be given at no cost to the licensee and no late fees shall be
- 5 charged to the licensee for such extension.
- 6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
