AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to requiring candidates for certain elected offices to post certain information regarding contributions on such candidate's campaign website

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The election law is amended by adding a new section 14-121 2 to read as follows:
- § 14-121. Contributions to be posted on campaign websites. 1. Any candidate for elected office for the office of the governor, the comptroller, the attorney general or any legislative district of the senate or assembly shall:
- 7 <u>a. post on the homepage of his or her campaign website a direct link</u> 8 <u>to the board of elections website to such candidate's campaign contributions.</u>
- b. post on the homepage of his or her campaign website all contributions over two hundred fifty dollars within thirty days of receipt; including the exact amount of each contribution and the identity of the donor.
- 2. Such candidate shall be responsible for ensuring that the information as required in paragraphs a and b of subdivision one of this section is posted.
- 17 <u>3. Any person who shall knowingly and willfully violate any provision</u> 18 <u>of this section shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.</u>
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
