AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the definition of person

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 125.05 of the penal law, the section heading, opening paragraph and closing paragraph as amended by chapter 1 of the laws
- 2 of 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 § 125.05 Homicide and related offenses; definition.
- 4 The following definition is applicable to this article:
- 5 "Person," when referring to the victim of a homicide, means a human
- 6 being who has been born and is alive. This provision shall be known as
- 7 "Mya's law".
- 8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
