AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to co-location of farms and renewable energy projects

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 309 of the agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:

 3 10. a. The advisory council on agriculture shall study and provide
- 4 recommendations to the commissioner on best practices to allow for 5 co-location in an effort to enhance compatibility between renewable
- 6 energy development and the protection of natural and agricultural
- 7 resources. Such recommendations on best practices shall focus on renewa-
- 8 ble energy projects and their impact on the loss of prime agricultural
- 9 lands. Any findings and recommendations pursuant to this subdivision
- shall be made available to the public, and may be included in the coun-
- 11 <u>cil's report pursuant to subdivision seven of this section.</u>
- 12 <u>b. "Co-location," as used in this section shall mean viable farmland</u>
- 13 eligible for the deliberate production of farm products and renewable
- 14 <u>energy in a single location.</u>
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
