AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to waiving certain liquor license renewal fees; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 66 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new subdivision 11 to read as follows:

11. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the fee for any renewal of a license required pursuant to sections sixty-four, sixty-four-a, sixty-four-b, sixty-four-c or sixty-four-d of this article shall be waived during the calendar year ending December thirty-first, two thousand twenty-one.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to annual 9 liquor license fees due on and after January 1, 2021; provided however, 10 this act shall expire December 31, 2021, when upon such date the provisions of this act shall be deemed repealed.
