AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to enacting the "Make Voting Easy Act" to require that the board of elections designate at least one early voting polling place for every full increment of twenty-five thousand registered voters in each county

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Make Voting Easy Act".

- § 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 8-600 of the election law, as amended by chapter 344 of the laws of 2020, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 6 (a) The board of elections shall designate polling places for early 7 voting, which may include the offices of the board of elections, for persons to vote early pursuant to this title; provided, however, that the municipality with the highest population in each county based on the 10 latest federal decennial census shall have at least one polling place 11 designated for early voting, and to the extent practicable if such muni-12 cipality has public transportation routes, such polling place shall be situated along such transportation routes. There shall be so designated 13 least one early voting polling place for every full increment of 14 [fifty] twenty-five thousand registered voters in each county; provided, 15 [however, the number of early voting polling places in a county shall 16 not be required to be greater than ten unless required by any other 17 18 provision of law, and a county with fewer than [fifty] twenty-five 19 thousand voters shall have at least one early voting polling place.
- 20 § 3. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 4 of section 8-600 of the election 21 law, as added by chapter 6 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as 22 follows:

1 (c) Polls shall be open for early voting for at least [five] eight 2 hours between nine o'clock in the morning and [six] eight o'clock in the 3 evening on each Saturday, Sunday and legal holiday during the early 4 voting period.

5 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to any 6 general, primary, run-off primary, or special election held thereafter.
