AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to insurance reserve funds for the Carmel central school district

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 6-n of the general municipal law, as amended by chapter 246 of the laws of 2020, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 (a) The governing board of any municipal corporation may establish a
4 reserve fund to be known as the insurance reserve fund. Upon the
5 creation of the fund, the municipality may make expenditures from the
6 fund for any loss, claim, action or judgment for which the municipal
7 corporation is authorized or required to purchase or maintain insurance,
8 except those kinds of risks for which insurance is authorized pursuant
9 to paragraph one, two, three, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen,
10 twenty-two or twenty-three of subsection (a) of section one thousand one
11 hundred thirteen of the insurance law, or for payments in lieu of
12 contributions under article eighteen of the labor law; provided however,
13 that no municipality shall make an expenditure from such fund for any
14 loss, claim, action or judgment for which the municipal corporation has
15 established a reserve fund under any other provision of law; provided,
16 further that the Scarsdale union free school district, the Mamaroneck
17 union free school district, the Minisink Valley central school district,
18 the Vernon Verona Sherrill central school district, the Ithaca city
19 school district, the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda union free school
20 district, the Bedford central school district, the Grand Island central
21 school district, the Tonawanda city school district, the enlarged city
22 school district of Middletown, the Frontier central school district, and
23 the Binghamton city school district and the Carmel central school
24 district may establish insurance reserve funds in compliance with this

1 section and article seventy-four of the education law and such school
2 districts may make expenditures in compliance with this section and
3 article seventy-four of the education law from such reserve fund for any
4 loss, claim, action or judgment for which the school districts are
5 authorized or required to purchase or maintain insurance for the kinds
6 of risks for which insurance is authorized pursuant to paragraph three
7 of subsection (a) of section one thousand one hundred thirteen of the
8 insurance law.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
