AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to a disclosure form for the surrender of a dog

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 117 of the agriculture and markets law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:
- 12. (a) Every pound, shelter, incorporated humane society or similar incorporated dog protective association, shall develop a form to be used upon the surrender of a dog by its owner to such entity. Such form shall request the following information from such owner:
 - (i) the reason or reasons for surrendering the dog;
- 8 (ii) whether the dog has been declared to be a dangerous dog; whether 9 such dog has ever exhibited aggressive tendencies;
 - (iii) whether the dog has ever bitten any person; and
- 11 (iv) any other information with regard to the dog which the owner 12 feels may be relevant to the future placement of the dog.
- 13 (b) The pound, shelter, incorporated humane society or similar incor-14 porated dog protective association which accepts dogs surrendered by its
- 15 owner to be sheltered and adopted out shall maintain the form and shall
- 16 disclose it to any prospective adoptive owner or any other person who
- 17 may shelter or harbor the dog for any period of time after its surren-
- 18 **der.**
