AN ACT to amend the state technology law, in relation to requiring the office of information technology services to cooperate with all state agencies in the implementation of language translation technology

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 103 of the state technology law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 8-a to read as follows:
- 8-a. (a) To advise and assist state agencies in the implementation of
 language translation technology on state agency websites containing
 information about the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") or programs, benefits or services related to COVID-19 within thirty days of the effective
 date of this subdivision; and on all state agency websites within ninety
 days of the effective date of this subdivision.
- 9 (b) Such language translation technology shall, at a minimum, allow
 10 users to translate the text of state agency websites into at least the
 11 twelve most common non-English languages spoken by individuals with
 12 limited-English proficiency in the state of New York, based on United
 13 States census data.
- 14 (c) As used in this subdivision, the term "state agency website" shall
 15 mean an internet website operated by or for a state agency. Such term
 16 shall include those websites operated on behalf of state agencies by
 17 other public or private entities, but shall not include any portions of
 18 the internet outside the control of the state agency.
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
