AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Assemblyman William 'Bill' Magee Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-m to 2 read as follows:
- § 344-m. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the 4 "Assemblyman William 'Bill' Magee Memorial Highway". All that portion 5 of the state highway system constituting state route thirteen within the 6 county of Madison shall be designated and known as the "Assemblyman William 'Bill' Magee Memorial Highway".
- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 9 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 10 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-11 12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
