AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to requiring certain information to be filed with the department of public service

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 2 121-b to read as follows:
- § 121-b. Filing of certain information. 1. All persons who intend to
 construct a gas gathering line or a pipeline facility, shall file with
 the department spatial mapping data, including but not limited to
 geographic information system data, detailing the location of such
 proposed gathering line or pipeline facility.
- 2. The department, in consultation with the department of environmental conservation, shall establish and maintain a computer mapping
 system for plotting the location of gathering lines and pipeline facilities. Such maps shall overlay locations subject to the provisions of
 article twenty-three of the environmental conservation law.
- 3. For purposes of this section, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
- 15 <u>(a) "Gathering line" means a pipeline that transports gas from a</u>
 16 <u>current production facility to a transmission line, main, or directly to</u>
 17 <u>an end user.</u>
- (b) "Pipeline facility" means new and existing pipeline, rights-ofway, and any related equipment, facility, or building, used in the
 transportation of gas, or in the treatment of gas during the course of
 transportation, in connection with the production, gathering, treatment
 or processing of such gas, but does not include any: (i) transmission
 and distribution system operated by a local distribution company subject
 to the jurisdiction of the commission for purposes of providing retail

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1 utility service; or (ii) transmission pipeline constructed by a natural
2 gas company under the authority of the federal Natural Gas Act (15
3 U.S.C.A. Section 717 et seq.). The department shall have the option to
4 incorporate any additional information regarding pipeline facilities.
5 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after
6 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amend7 ment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implemen8 tation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and
9 completed on or before such effective date.
