AN ACT to amend chapter 63 of the laws of 2021 amending the environmental conservation law relating to supermarkets providing excess edible food to food relief organizations, in relation to extending the effectiveness of certain provisions thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 6 of chapter 63 of the laws of 2021 amending the environmental conservation law relating to supermarkets providing excess edible food to food relief organizations, is amended to read as follows:

§ 6. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however that sections one, two, three and four of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as [a] chapter 56 of the laws of 2020[77 amending the environmental conservation law relating to requiring supermarkets to make excess food available to qualifying entities, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 4176-A and A. 4398-A,] takes effect, provided, further, that section four of this act shall expire and be deemed repealed on December 31, [2021] 2026.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
