AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to exempting any federal or state stimulus check that is the result of a declared national or state disaster emergency from money judgments

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 5205 of the civil practice law and rules is amended by adding a new subdivision (p) to read as follows:
- (p) Exemption for federal or state stimulus checks. 1. No federal or state stimulus check that is the result of a declared national or state disaster emergency shall be subject to execution, garnishment, or attachment or any other legal process, except such part as a court determines to be unnecessary for the reasonable requirements of the judgment debtor and the debtor's dependents.
- 9 <u>2. For the purposes of this subdivision, the term "stimulus check"</u>
  10 <u>shall mean any economic impact payment sent by the government to taxpay-</u>
  11 <u>ers.</u>
- 2 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
