AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to tuition assistance program awards

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraphs (ii) and (vi) of paragraph a of subdivision 3 of section 667 of the education law, as amended by section 1 of part B of chapter 60 of the laws of 2000, are amended to read as follows:

4 (ii) Except for students as noted in subparagraph (iii) of this para-5 graph, the base amount as determined from subparagraph (i) of this para-6 graph, shall be reduced in relation to income as follows:
