AN ACT to amend chapter 695 of the laws of 1994 amending the civil service law relating to injunctive relief in improper practice cases, in relation to extending the effectiveness of provisions contained therein

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 695 of the laws of 1994 amending the civil service law relating to injunctive relief in improper practice cases, as amended by chapter 64 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 § 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1995, provided, however, 6 that subdivisions 4 and 5 of section 209-a of the civil service law, as 7 added by section one of this act, shall expire and be deemed repealed on 8 June 30, [2021] 2023.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
