AN ACT to amend the civil rights law, in relation to a gender-neutral marker on all benefits applications

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 79-q of the civil rights law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

2-a. All application materials, instructions, public quidance, and related materials associated with a benefits application process, including electronic and online materials and applications shall be amended and updated to clarify that any person can select or indicate a gender or sex designation of "x" when such information is requested. The content of the gender or sex field shall not delay or otherwise hinder access to services for any applicant.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
