Introduced by Sens. GAUGHRAN, BROOKS -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Children and Families -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to excluding certain kindergartens and pre-kindergartens from the definition of child day care

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Clause (D) of subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 390 of the social services law, as added by chapter 750 of the laws of 1990, is amended to read as follows:

2 (D) a kindergarten, pre-kindergarten, or nursery school for children  
3 three years of age or older, or after-school program for children operated by a public school district or by a private school or academy which  
4 is providing elementary or secondary education or both, in accordance  
5 with the compulsory education requirements of the education law,  
6 provided that the kindergarten, pre-kindergarten, nursery school, or  
7 after school program is located on the premises or campus where the  
8 elementary or secondary education is provided. Provided however, a  
9 kindergarten or a pre-kindergarten operated by a public school district  
10 shall not be considered a child day care if the kindergarten or pre-kindergarten  
11 is not located on the premises or campus where the elementary  
12 or secondary education is provided.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
