AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of Holland as the "Robert Segool Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-m to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-m. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the
"Robert Segool Memorial Highway". The portion of State Route 16 between
Emery Road and Route 400, in the town of Holland, county of Erie, shall
be designated and known as the "Robert Segool Memorial Highway".

- 7 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal8 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system
 9 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid
 10 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig11 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of
 12 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be
 13 changed as a result of this act.
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
