AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to a report by the division for small business; and to amend chapter 731 of the laws of 2019 amending the executive law relating to regulatory fines for small businesses, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:
