AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to animal response teams

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The article heading of article 26-B of the agriculture and markets law, as added by chapter 182 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

[ANIMAL] EMERGENCY RESPONSE [TEAMS] SERVICES
