AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to allowing for a certain amount of required clinical training and competency to be completed through simulation experience

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Article 130 of the education law, as added by chapter 987 of the laws of 1971, is amended by adding a new subarticle 5 to read as follows:

Subarticle 5. Clinical training and competency.

Section 6518. Clinical training and competency.

§ 6518. Clinical training and competency. Notwithstanding any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, for those professions under this title that require a supervised clinical training, clinical education or clinical continuing competency component, or the equivalent as determined by the department, for initial licensure or license renewal, the commissioner shall be authorized to permit at least one-third of such clinical training to be obtained through simulation experience acceptable to the department and pursuant to regulation. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the department from allowing an institution of post-secondary education to provide greater than one-third of such training through simulation experience upon application by that institution in such form as the department shall require.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law.
