- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the reporting of lyme and tick-borne disease infection after death

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section
2799 to read as follows:
<u>§ 2799. Reporting of lyme and tick-borne disease infection after</u>

4 death. If a coroner, pathologist, medical examiner, or other person 5 gualified to conduct an examination of a deceased person discovers that

6 at the time of death the individual was afflicted with lyme or other

7 tick-borne diseases, he or she shall report the case promptly to the

8 department according to the manner prescribed by the commissioner.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 10 have become a law.
