AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to including acts designated as hate crimes to the definition of designated offense for purposes of eavesdropping and video surveillance warrants

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 8 of section 700.05 of the criminal procedure
- 2 law is amended by adding a new paragraph (w) to read as follows:
- 3 (w) Any of the acts designated as a hate crime as defined in section
- 4 485.05 of the penal law.
- 5 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
