AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to the construction of facilities for chemical dependence services that promote the privacy of individuals

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (b) of section 32.29 of the mental hygiene law, 2 as added by chapter 558 of the laws of 1999, is amended to read as 3 follows:

(b) The construction of a facility shall require the prior approval of such commissioner if the provider of services seeking to engage in such construction receives funding from the office of [alcoholism and substance abuse] addiction services and supports pursuant to this chapter and/or seeks a funding source for such construction project other than from the mental health services facilities improvement program, or its successor agency, directly or indirectly through a closely related entity; provided, however, that such facilities shall be designed and constructed in a manner that promotes privacy while bathing, sleeping, using restrooms and receiving individual counseling services, while also allowing for maximization of the use of such facility.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
