AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Trooper Brian S. Falb Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-n to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-n. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Trooper Brian S. Falb Memorial Bridge". All that portion of the state 5 highway system constituting the bridges on interstate eighty-seven, 6 crossing the Saranac river in the town of Plattsburgh, county of Clinton, shall each be designated and known as the "Trooper Brian S. Falb 8 Memorial Bridge".

- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-10 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-13 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 14 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridges shall not be 15 changed as a result of this act.
- 16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
