AN ACT to amend the cannabis law, in relation to ensure the inclusion of lesbian, gay, and bisexual individuals in the award of adult-use cannabis licenses

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 87 of the cannabis law is amended 2 to read as follows:

- 2. The board's social and economic equity plan shall also promote diversity in commerce, ownership and employment, and opportunities for social and economic equity in the adult-use cannabis industry. A goal shall be established to award fifty percent of adult-use cannabis licenses to social and economic equity applicants and ensure inclusion of:
- 9 (a) individuals from communities disproportionately impacted by the 10 enforcement of cannabis prohibition;
 - (b) minority-owned businesses;
- 12 (c) women-owned businesses;

- 13 (d) minority and women-owned businesses, as defined in paragraph (d) 14 of subdivision five of this section;
- 15 (e) distressed farmers, as defined in subdivision five of this 16 section; [and]
- 17 (f) service-disabled veterans: and
- 18 (g) lesbian, gay, and bisexual individuals.
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
