AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring the state university of New York and the city university of New York to adopt certain provisions related to student mental health

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 362 to 2 read as follows:

- § 362. Student mental health. 1. The university shall create and administer, at the start of a student's freshman and junior year, a mental health survey. Such survey shall include, but not be limited to, questions regarding a student's mental health and general well-being. Participation in such survey shall be optional to each student, and the results of such survey from participating students shall be sent to the chancellor of the university, appropriate staff including but not limit-10 ed to the president of each state-operated institution of the university, any oversight council as mandated pursuant to section three hundred 11 fifty-six of this article and any licensed mental health practitioners employed by any of the state-operated institutions of the university.
- 2. There shall be a five member committee established within the 15 university that shall be responsible for engaging with and disseminating mental health resources to faculty, staff and students. Such committee shall be composed of a group of individuals chosen by the chancellor of the university in conjunction with the presidents of each state-operated institution of the university. Such committee shall also be responsible for making recommendations to the regents of the university regarding 21 how often and in what manner faculty of the university shall provide 22 mental health wellness days and excused absences from class for students.
- 24 3. All faculty and other staff of the university shall be required on 25 an annual basis to undergo mental health training with a focus on iden-

tifying or recognizing signs of mental distress among students. The chancellor of the university, in conjunction with the commissioner, shall prescribe the form and manner in which such training shall be provided.

- 5 <u>4. The university shall also take the following actions regarding</u> 6 <u>student mental health:</u>
 - (a) review enrollment and re-enrollment policies of the university and create specific provisions for students that may require extended mental health leave;

- 16 § 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6235 to read 17 as follows:
- § 6235. Student mental health. 1. The city university shall create and 18 administer, at the start of a student's freshman and junior year a 19 20 mental health survey. Such survey shall include, but not be limited to, questions regarding a student's mental health and general well-being. 21 Participation in such survey shall be optional to each student, and the 22 results of such survey from participating students shall be sent to the 23 24 chancellor of the city university, appropriate staff including but not 25 limited to the president of each senior and community college of the 26 city university, any oversight council of the city university and any 27 licensed mental health practitioners employed by any of the senior or community colleges within the city university. 28
- 2. There shall be a five member committee established within the city 29 30 university that shall be responsible for engaging with and disseminating mental health resources to faculty, staff and students. Such committee 31 32 shall be composed of a group of individuals chosen by the chancellor of 33 the city university in conjunction with the presidents of each city-operated institution of the university. Such committee shall also be 34 responsible for making recommendations to the board of trustees regard-35 ing how often and in what manner faculty of the city university shall 36 37 provide mental health wellness days and excused absences from class for 38 students.
 - 3. All faculty and other staff of the city university shall be required on an annual basis to undergo mental health training with a focus on identifying or recognizing signs of mental distress among students. The chancellor of the city university, in conjunction with the commissioner, shall prescribe the form and manner in which such training shall be provided.
- 45 <u>4. The city university shall also take the following actions regarding</u>
 46 <u>student mental health:</u>
- 47 (a) review enrollment and re-enrollment policies of the city universi-48 ty and create specific provisions for students that may require extended 49 mental health leave;
- 50 <u>(b) create opportunities for telehealth and virtual counseling</u> 51 <u>options</u>;
- 52 <u>(c) require a mental health seminar to be included in all orientation</u>
 53 <u>programs for newly enrolled students; and</u>
- 54 <u>(d) institute other programs to address and improve student mental</u> 55 <u>health.</u>
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
