AN ACT to amend a chapter of the laws of 2021 establishing the New York state rural ambulance services task force, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 3503-C and A. 1561-C, in relation to modifying the membership of the New York state rural ambulance services task force and extending the report submission date

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraphs (vi) and (vii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 and subdivision 4 of section 1 of a chapter of the laws of 2021 establishing the New York state rural ambulance services task force, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 3503-C and A. 1561-C, are amended and a new subparagraph (viii) is added to paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 to read as follows:

(vi) two members appointed by the office of fire prevention and control; [and]

9 (vii) two members appointed by the bureau of emergency medical 10 services[-]; and

## (viii) two members appointed by the commissioner of labor.

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- 4. Within [twelve] eighteen months of the effective date of this act, the department of health shall submit a report detailing the findings of the study to the governor, the temporary president of the senate, and the speaker of the assembly.
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 17 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2021 establishing the New York state 18 rural ambulance services task force, as proposed in legislative bills 19 numbers S. 3503-C and A. 1561-C, takes effect.
