AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to excluding certain sums due from the definition of "debt"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 18 of the state finance law, as amended by section 1 of part C of chapter 81 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (b) "debt" shall mean any liquidated sum due and owing any state agen5 cy which has accrued pursuant to law or through contract, subrogation,
 6 tort or other cause of action, except for (i) a sum due and owing any
 7 state agency for a liability resulting from tuition, fees, room and
 8 board, educational benefit overpayments, student loans, or other charges
 9 incurred by a student; or (ii) a liability resulting from taxes or other
 0 impositions administered by the state commissioner of taxation and
- 10 impositions administered by the state commissioner of taxation and 11 finance, regardless of whether there is an outstanding judgment for that
- 12 sum;
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
