AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to participation in state contracts

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section 139-m to read as follows:

§ 139-m. Participation in contract prohibited; health insurance; 3 4 transgender status. 1. A clause shall be inserted in all specifications 5 or contracts hereafter made or awarded by the state or any public 6 department, agency or official thereof, for work or services performed 7 or to be performed, for goods sold or to be sold pursuant to which any contractor, to whom any contract shall be let, granted or awarded, agrees, as a material condition of the contract, that neither such 9 10 contractor nor any substantially owned or affiliated person, firm, part-11 nership or corporation has participated or is participating or shall 12 participate in a health plan offered which does not cover services for transgender, non-binary, and gender expansive people, including but not 13 14 limited to hormone replacement therapy, gender-affirming surgery, and 15 treatment typically associated with one particular gender.

2. Any such contract shall be rendered forfeit and void by the state 17 comptroller, if, subsequent to execution, such person, firm, partnership 18 or corporation has been participating in such health plan which fails to provide services for transgender, non-binary, and gender expansive people.

Nothing contained in this section shall operate to impair any 22 existing contract, except that any renewal, amendment or modification of 23 such contract occurring on or after the effective date of this section 24 shall be subject to the conditions specified in this section.
- 25 4. The comptroller of the state shall have the power to issue rules 26 <u>and regulations pursuant to this section.</u>
- § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 27 28 have become a law and shall apply to all contracts entered into, renewed or modified on and after the effective date of this act.
