AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to zero-emissions for trains

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The section heading and subdivision 1 of section 19-0306-b 2 of the environmental conservation law, as added by chapter 423 of the 3 laws of 2021, are amended to read as follows:

Zero-emissions cars [and], trucks and trains.

- 1. It shall be a goal of the state that one hundred percent of new 5 6 passenger cars and trucks offered for sale or lease, or sold, or leased, 7 for registration in the state shall be zero-emissions by two thousand 8 thirty-five. It shall be a further goal of the state that one hundred percent of trains purchased by the state or any public authority thereof 10 for commuter rail service as defined in paragraph a of subdivision one 11 of section ninety-seven-a of the railroad law, be zero-emissions by two 12 thousand thirty-five. It shall be a further goal of the state that one 13 hundred percent of medium-duty and heavy-duty vehicles offered for sale 14 or lease, or sold, or leased, for registration in the state be zero-emissions by two thousand forty-five for all operations where feasible. It 16 shall be further a goal of the state to transition to one hundred 17 percent zero-emissions off-road vehicles and equipment by two thousand 18 thirty-five where feasible.
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
