- AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to prohibiting the transfer of unexpended moneys from funds receiving moneys from a dedicated fee into any other fund

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section 73-a to read as follows:

3 <u>§ 73-a.</u> Transfer of funds. Notwithstanding any provision of law to 4 the contrary, unexpended moneys in any fund that:

5 <u>1. receives revenues from a dedicated fee;</u>

2. provides that moneys in the fund shall be kept separate from and
7 shall not be commingled with other moneys in the custody of the comp8 troller; and

- 9 <u>3. provides that moneys in the fund shall be expended only for the</u> 10 <u>purpose designated in the fund</u>
- 11 shall not be transferred to any other fund or account or used for any 12 purpose other than that designated by the fund.
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
