AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring student identification cards to contain the new national suicide prevention lifeline number, 9-8-8

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 207-b
2 to read as follows:

3 § 207-b. Student identification cards. 1. Each institution of higher
4 education authorized by the legislature or by the regents of the univer-
5 sity of the state of New York to confer academic degrees in this state
6 which issues student identification cards to its students shall have on
7 such cards the national suicide prevention lifeline number, 9-8-8.

8 2. Each year, prior to the start of a new school year, each institu-
9 tion of higher education authorized by the legislature or by the regents
10 of the university of the state of New York to confer academic degrees in
11 this state which issues student identification cards to its students
12 shall certify to the regents that such identification cards have the
13 information required under subdivision one of this section.

14 § 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 1527-b to
15 read as follows:

16 § 1527-b. Student identification cards. 1. Each school district,
17 private school, or charter school organized under this chapter which
18 issues student identification cards to its students shall have on such
19 cards issued to students in the ninth through twelfth grades the
20 national suicide prevention lifeline number, 9-8-8.

21 2. Each year, prior to the start of a new school year, each school
22 district, private school, or charter school organized under this chapter
23 which issues student identification cards to its students shall certify
24 to the regents that such identification cards have the information
25 required under subdivision one of this section.

26 § 3. This act shall take effect July 16, 2022 and shall apply to
27 student identification cards that are issued, modified, altered or
28 amended on or after such date.
