AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to expanding the ethical duties of public officers and employees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 74 of the public officers law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:

3-a. Other ethical duties. It shall be the ethical duty of any person 4 or entity subject to the provisions of this section to promptly report 5 to the commission information not protected by attorney-client or prose-6 cutorial investigative privilege about activity known to be in violation 7 of this section or any other law which any person or entity has engaged in with respect to activity that is within the jurisdiction of the joint commission on public ethics established pursuant to section ninety-four 10 of the executive law. Knowledge of discriminatory harassment need not be 11 reported by the subject of such harassment or by another if confided in 12 confidence on the basis of personal friendship. There shall be no 13 retaliation against a person or entity making such a report in good faith on information and belief, and any person aggrieved by such retal-15 <u>iation may bring a civil action for compensatory and exemplary damages.</u> § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
