AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to adding telephone numbers to a do-not-call list at the outset of certain telemarketing calls

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 399-z of the general business law, 2 as amended by chapter 239 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as

- 2. No telemarketer or seller shall engage in telemarketing at any time other than between 8:00 A.M. and 9:00 P.M. at the location of the customer unless the customer has given his or her express consent to the call at a different time. Telemarketers shall provide, in a clear and coherent manner using words with common and everyday meanings, at the 9 beginning of each telemarketing sales call all of the following informa-10 tion, provided that the information set forth in paragraphs a and b of this subdivision shall be given to the customer first:
 - a. the telemarketer's name and the person on whose behalf the solicitation is being made, if other than the telemarketer;
 - b. the [purpose of the telephone call] option to be automatically added to the seller's entity specific do-not-call list, as required by subdivisions seven, eight, and nine of this section;
- c. [the identity of the goods or services for which 18 charged; and
- 19 d.] whether the call is being recorded:

- d. the purpose of the telephone call; and
- e. the identity of the goods or services for which a fee will be 21 22 charged.
- 23 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 24 have become a law.
