AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to establishing the everyone can play grant program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 10 of section 54 of the state finance law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph v to read as follows:
- 3 <u>v. Everyone can play grant program. (i) When used in this paragraph,</u>
  4 <u>unless otherwise expressly stated:</u>
  - (1) "Municipality" shall mean a county, city, town, or village.
- 6 (2) "Recreation facility" shall mean playgrounds, athletic fields, and 7 recreation centers, together with necessary buildings, structures, and 8 equipment.
- 9 (3) "Handicap accessible aspects" shall mean playground equipment
  10 approved in accordance with accessibility quidelines pursuant to the
  11 federal Americans with Disabilities Act of nineteen hundred ninety, as
  12 amended, which shall include but not be limited to, playground structures, swings, slides, climbers, and spring riders.
- (ii) Within the annual amounts appropriated therefor, the secretary of
  state may award competitive grants of up to one hundred thousand dollars
  to municipalities to cover the costs for the creation of handicap accessible aspects in new or existing recreation facilities.
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
