AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation to authorizing the village of Voorheesville to appoint village officers who do not reside within such village

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new subdivision 32 to read as follows:

32. Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter or any other gener-4 al law, local law, ordinance or special act, the village board of trustees of the incorporated village of Voorheesville, Albany county, may, by resolution, provide that any appointed village officer of the village of Voorheesville, Albany county, need not be a resident of such village, but shall be a resident of a contiguous county.

- 9 § 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new 10 subdivision 72 to read as follows:
- 72. In the village of Voorheesville, in the county of Albany, the 11 12 provisions of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he 13 14 or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are 15 required to be exercised, shall not prevent a person from being 16 appointed as a village officer of the village of Voorheesville provided 17 that such person resides in a contiguous county. Provided, however, the 18 person performing the functions of an appointed village officer in any 19 other village shall be an elector of such village, unless otherwise provided by law. 20
- 21 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
