AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Senior Investigator Thomas M. O'Neil Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-n to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-n. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the
"Senior Investigator Thomas M. O'Neil Memorial Bridge". The bridge over
the Sagtikos Parkway on Crooked Hill Road between Community College
Drive and Pilgrim Center Road in the town of Islip, county of Suffolk,
shall be designated and known as the "Senior Investigator Thomas M.
O'Neil Memorial Bridge".

- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system
 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid
 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of
 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be
 changed as a result of this act.
- 16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
