AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to imposing a moratorium on increasing gas and electric prices, rates and charges

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 2 72-b to read as follows:
- § 72-b. Moratorium on increases in gas or electricity prices. 1. No
 corporation or person shall set any prices, rates or charges for gas or
 electricity which are higher than such corporation's or person's prices,
 rates or charges for gas or electricity on the effective date of this
 section.
- 2. No corporation or person who received an approved electric and gas
 years plan from the commission between January first, two thousand twenty-one and the effective date of this section shall formally request a
 rate case from the commission for a period of four years from the effective date of this section.
- 3. No corporation or person who did not receive an approved electric
 and gas rate plan from the commission between January first, two thousand twenty-one and the effective date of this section shall formally
 request a rate case from the commission for a period of two years from
- 17 the effective date of this section.
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
