AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assault on a straphanger

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "straphanger protection act".

§ 2. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 120.80 to read 4 as follows:

§ 120.80 Assault on a straphanger.

A person is guilty of assault on a straphanger when he or she strikes, 7 shoves, kicks, or otherwise subjects another person to physical contact that results in such person falling onto subway tracks.

Assault on a straphanger is a class C felony.
