AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Trooper James R. Gohery Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-n to 2 read as follows:
- § 344-n. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the
  "Trooper James R. Gohery Memorial Bridge". All that portion of the state
  highway system constituting the Jerusalem Avenue overpass crossing the
  Wantagh State Parkway in the town of Hempstead, county of Nassau, shall
  be designated and known as the "Trooper James R. Gohery Memorial
  Bridge".
- 9 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-10 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 11 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid
- 12 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-13 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of
- 14 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be
- 15 changed as a result of this act.
- 16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
