AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to proceedings for appointment of a guardian for personal needs or property management

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Karilyn's 2 + 1aw".
- 3 § 2. Paragraph 1 of subdivision (b) of section 81.07 of the mental 4 hygiene law, as amended by chapter 438 of the laws of 2004, is amended 5 to read as follows:
- 1. set the date on which the order to show cause is heard no more than twenty-eight days from the date of the signing of the order to show cause. The court may for good cause shown set a date less than twenty-eight days from the date of the signing of the order to show cause; provided that where the order to show cause concerns family visitation rights, the court shall set the date on which the order to show cause is heard and for which a temporary order will be issued no more than ten
- 13 <u>days from the date of the signing of the order to show cause</u>. The date 14 of the hearing may be adjourned only for good cause shown;
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
