AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to owner liability for failure of an operator to comply with traffic-control devices in the village of Pelham Manor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subdivision (a) of section 1111-f of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 460 of the laws of 2021, is amended to read as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the village of Pelham 4 5 Manor is hereby authorized and empowered to adopt and amend a local law б or ordinance establishing a demonstration program imposing monetary liability on the owner of a vehicle for failure of an operator thereof 7 to comply with traffic-control indications in such village in accordance 8 with the provisions of this section. Such demonstration program shall 9 10 empower such village to install and operate traffic-control signal photo 11 violation-monitoring devices at no more than one intersection within and 12 under the jurisdiction of such village at any one time [-,]; provided, 13 however, that where one of the two highways joining one another at such 14 intersection is a state highway maintained by the state, such village 15 may install and operate such traffic-control signal photo violation-mon-16 itoring device in a manner affecting traffic proceeding along such state 17 highway at such intersection if it has obtained approval in writing from 18 the department of transportation, and the department of transportation may at any time rescind or modify such approval. 19

20 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 21 have become a law; provided, however, that the amendments to subdivision 22 (a) of section 1111-f of the vehicle and traffic law made by section one 23 of this act shall not affect the repeal of such subdivision and shall be 24 deemed repealed therewith.
